Day 1: Monday 13th April

Visit the Temora Aircraft Museum or Rural and Ambulance Museum

- Travel 150 kms to Temora
- Buy lunch items at Woolworths Temora to eat at the seating in Centenary Park
- Visit Temora Aircraft Museum or Rural and Ambulance Museum

Visit the Fish Fossil Museum at Canowindra

- Travel 200 kms to Canowindra with morning tea at Grenfell

Day 3: Wednesday 15th April

Balloon Ride and travel to Bathurst for Mt Panorama

- Purchase food at Foodworks plus fuel to depart at 10:00am
- **10:00am** Drive to Bathurst - 104 kms.
- Drive around Mt Panorama (6.2 kms) and visit Motor Racing Museum cost \$8pp. Picnic lunch on the Museum grounds
- Drive to Wentworth Falls
- **Accommodation:** Rest Easy Motel, Wentworth Falls with 15 rooms reserved at \$100 per night, 3-5 Old Bathurst Rd, contact Kevin 0413 094 728 or info@resteasymotel.com.au.

Day 4: Thursday 16th April

Visit Leura, Echo Point (Three Sisters) and Scenic World (Scenic Railway) - 5 kms

Other Options:

- Bush Walking at Wentworth Falls or Blackheath
- Jenolan Caves – admission \$47pp per cave; turn off 50kms from Wentworth Falls but note access is via a narrow winding road
- Zig Zag Railway – Bells Line of Road, to reopen late 2019 at 41 kms

Day 5: Friday 17th April

Lunch in Newnes Valley - 200kms return

- Purchase lunch items and fuel
- Coffee stop at Pavilion at Hydro Majestic, Medlow Bath
- Drive to Newnes in Wolgan Valley – 90 kms with last 10 km dirt road.
- Picnic lunch on verandah at former pub with total cost \$50 for group for use of verandah and facilities
