COST: \$10 per person (cash) will include guided museum tour and tea/coffee and cake

- 1) Morning tea, (only if you wish to self-cater, there will be a tea stop where there are café & bakery options).
 - 2) Self catered lunch (Tea/coffee and Cake will be provided by the Gliding museum)
 - 3) Picnic tables and chairs for said lunch (shade will be provided)

We will leave the Aircraft Viewing Area and travel on pleasant and attractive roads through Riddles Creek to Gisborne where we will stop for morning tea. Then it's onto the Melbourne Gliding Museum in Bacchus Marsh via a stop at the Swans Road Lookout. 50 or so steps from the new car park will provide you with an extensive view over The Marsh. At the museum we will be taken on a guided historical tour of the museum which contains over 50 historic gliders and other gliding archival material, including books, manuals, photographs, films, glider launching winches, aircraft plans, trophies and other memorabilia. After the museum tour we can set up our picnic tables and chairs in the shade on one of their big hangers and use the club's BBQ facilities should you need them. The museum will provide tea/coffee and cake to have with your lunch as part of the \$10 per person entry fee. Total travel distance from viewing area to the museum is 96km.
